### Special Note for Pharmacy Majors:

Introductory pharmacy practice experiences (IPPE) are required for all students entering the professional pharmacy curriculum. They provide a broad overview of pharmacy practice and the various roles and responsibilities that pharmacists play within the health care system. Students enrolled in the IPPE courses are required to obtain 100 hours per year during the summer, fall and/or spring semesters (P1, P2, & P3) in a specific pharmacy practice setting for a total of 300 hours by the completion of the P3 year. It is expected that students will complete IPPE in both community and institutional practice settings as specified by the course coordinator and as required by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE).
