Description of Internship Provider:

The Center for Career Development (CCD) supports students by providing programs and experiences that promote self-awareness and engagement as they identify a course of study and pursue career opportunities. Through partnership with employers, alumni, faculty, and staff, we connect students to career development resources, internships, experiential learning, and post-graduate opportunities.

Description of Internship Position:

Graphic Design Interns assist the marketing team in creating various advertisements and marketing material for the CCD. Graphic designers are responsible for creating various marketing collateral as assigned, including flyers, posters, large-scale banners, bus ads, etc. Students may also be asked to attend and photograph events hosted by the CCD. Interested candidates must be able to supply 3-5 design samples in order to be considered for this position. This position requires students to have experience in graphic design as well as proficiency with Adobe Photoshop, InDesign, and Illustrator. Photography and photo editing skills are preferred. Video skills are also a plus.
