

BUILDING YOUR LINKEDIN PROFILE

PHOTO

Use a high quality photo. No selfies or cropped pictures! Come to the CCD to have a free professional photo taken.

HEADLINE

Identify yourself as a UConn student or based on a current position or your career aspirations.

LOCATION & INDUSTRY

Use the metropolitan area closest to where you will be searching for jobs or internships. Choose the industry closest to your major or career aspirations.

LINKEDIN PAGE URL

Customize the public URL to your profile to remove extra characters and make it easy to add to your résumé.

SUMMARY

Think of your LinkedIn Summary as an online version of your “elevator pitch.” It may be written in the first- or third-person, and should highlight your background, skills, and interests. Use keywords or industry-specific language for your target employers when appropriate.

EXPERIENCE

Share experiences that are relevant to your career goals as you would on your résumé; include the organization name, your role or title, dates of employment, and a summary of your achievements and responsibilities. Your LinkedIn experience can expand on your résumé bullets. Have your master résumé critiqued at the CCD before posting. Add samples of your work or projects.

EDUCATION



GROUPS

Join groups to find alumni and professionals from your industry of interest to add to your network.

FOLLOWING

Follow companies and schools of interest to see regular updates from organizations.

ADVICE FOR CONTACTING

Include how you would like to be contacted. As with all social media, be careful of what personal information you make public. Review your privacy settings.

CONNECTIONS

Send requests to connect to your professional connections. Go to the individual's page, click on the triangle next to "Send InMail," select "Connect." Customize your message and send invitation.
